Thank you for your request for information relating to Right To Buy applications.

You have requested the following information:

**1. Under FOI Act 2000, please provide me with the number of Right To Buy applications received for council-owned homes, broken down by month from February 2024 to January 2025.**

**2. If there is still time in this request, please also provide me with the total current number of social housing properties owned by the council, and the number on the same date in 2020.**

For Questions 1 and 2, we can confirm that we do not hold this information and are informing you as required under Section 1(1) of the Act.

Coventry City Council does not own any housing stock as this was transferred to Citizen Housing (formerly Whitefriars) in September 2000 through Large Scale Voluntary Transfer.

This transfer also involved movement of responsibility for management of the housing stock, including repairs and maintenance and the setting and collection of rents along with any right-to-buy activities.

For clarity, the Council relinquished responsibility regarding these matters in their entirety as part of the transfer.
