

Toolkit for Life For Primary Schools



This course is for learners aged 5 to 11 who are disengaged from the core curriculum and respond better to a practical way of learning. It also provides insights into career pathways which may inspire them to dream of what they want to be when they leave school.

Learners receive a certificate of participation recognising their achievement. Their Wellbeing is also monitored.

The course comprises 12 different one-day sessions available Monday – Friday. It's provided on a rolling carousel basis so learners can jump off and on throughout the year. It takes place at a central Coventry venue or may be provided on school premises if there are sufficient learners to make it cost-effective.
