

PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

City of Coventry (Allesley Park Area)(20mph Speed Limit) Order 2025

Notice is hereby given that Coventry City Council ("the Council"), under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order ("the Order"). The Council proposes to introduce a new 20mph speed limit on the lengths of road named below.
