Cuckooing or Home Invasion

In 2024, cases of cuckooing or home invasion made up 28% of all criminal exploitation concerns for adults.

Keep an eye out for the following indicators:

- Has the person been forced or manipulated out of their home by people who
 use their home as a base to sell drugs or facilitate sexual exploitation?
- Does the person receive a large number of unexplained texts and phone calls or do they have multiple phones?
- Does the person have relationships with controlling and/or older individuals or groups?
- Is the person isolated from peers or social networks?
- Is there an increase in anti-social behaviour, unexplained people, and cars or bikes visiting the property?
- Is there damage to the door or is the door propped open?
- Are there unknown people pressing buzzers to gain access to the building?
- Is there a lack of healthcare visitors to properties of people with care needs?
- Does the person live out of one room of the property?
- Does the person have to ask for permission to use the kitchen or bathroom facilities?
