Sexual Exploitation

In 2024, cases of sexual exploitation made up 22% of all exploitation concerns for adults.

Keep an eye out for the following indicators:

- Does the person have restricted or no access to their earnings?
- Was the person deceived about the work they would be doing?
- Is the person closely guarded or controlled?
- Does the person lack access to their documents?
- Is the person working off a debt that never seems to get smaller?
- Does the person have an English vocabulary of only sexualised words?
- Has the person given false personal information or cannot produce any personal information?
- Does the person live in cramped or inappropriate accommodation?
- Is the person being moved between suspected brothels?
- Are there male visitors calling day and night and only staying for a short time?
- Are there signs of sexual services being provided nearby, such as cards and advertisements?
- Does the person have signs of sexual abuse.
