

PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

City of Coventry (Beechwood Avenue)(20mph Speed Limit Zone) **Order 2025**

Notice is hereby given that Coventry City Council ("the Council"), under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order ("the Order").

The Council proposes to introduce a new 20mph Speed Limit Zone on that part of Beechwood Avenue commencing 62 metres westerly of the westernmost junction of Hartington Crescent and continuing to 130 metres north westerly of the rail bridge. The Order is proposed for the purposes of public safety and to create a safer social space within the Highway, with more attractive environments for walking and cycling.

A copy of this Notice, the draft Order, Plan and Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the Council House (reception area) Earl Street, Coventry, CV1 5RR during normal office hours and on the Council's website 'www.coventry.gov.uk/tro'.
