

Notice of Intent

Proposed Installation of Controlled Crossing (TOUCAN)
Coundon Park Cycle Scheme

Notice is hereby given that, Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, intends to install a controlled TOUCAN crossing at the following location:-

Coundon Wedge Drive	Toucan (southwest of its junction with North Brook Road) with controlled area (zig zags) from a point approximately 120 metres southwest of the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout with Brownhill Green Road in a southwesterly direction for approximately 41 metres.

The Toucan crossing will be used by both cyclists and pedestrians and provide a necessary and safe crossing point along the route. The works to install the crossing are expected to be completed by the end of June 2025.
