You have requested the following information:

# 1. Please could you confirm if Coventry City Council currently offers MOT tests for cars (privately owned)?

Yes. However, we mainly carry our taxi MOT testing on our MOT bays; private MOTs are limited to two per day.

And if so, would it be possible to answer the following questions?

## 2. From January 2024 - January 2025, how many MOT tests were carried out on cars per month?

We have carried out approximately 95 private MOT tests.

3. How much do you charge for an MOT test on a car?

£50 (free retest).

4. Do you offer repairs too, or just the MOT test?

No.

### 5. How many test centres does your council have?

One.
