

TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

NOTICE OF MAKING

City of Coventry (Beechwood Avenue)(20mph Speed Limit Zone) Order 2025

Notice is hereby given that Coventry City Council ("the Council"), under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), has made the above Traffic Regulation Order ("the Order") which will come into operation on 6 June 2025

The effect of this Order shall be to reduce the speed limit from 30mph to 20mph on:

- i) Beechwood Avenue, from a point 62 metres westerly of the westernmost junction of Hartington Crescent in a generally north and westerly direction to a point 130 metres north westerly of the railway bridge.

The Order is required for the purposes of public safety and to create a safer social space within the Highway, with more attractive environments for walking and cycling.

A copy of this Notice, the Order, plan and Statement of Reasons for making the Order may be inspected at the Council House (reception area) Earl Street, Coventry and on the Council's website 'www.coventry.gov.uk/tro'

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from date the order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
