

Notice of Intent

Proposed Installation of Controlled Crossings (SPARROW) Charter Avenue Cycle Extension Scheme

Notice is hereby given that, Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, intends to install controlled crossings at the following locations:-

Cannon Hill Road	New controlled crossing (approximately 5 metres south of its junction with Tutbury Avenue).
A45 Fletchamstead Highway	Altered controlled crossing (approximately 5 metres north west of its junction with Canley Ford)

The Sparrow crossings will be used by both cyclists and pedestrians and provide a necessary and safe crossing point along the route. The works to install the crossings are expected to be completed by the end of July 2025.
