Thank you for your request for information relating to Data on Experimental Traffic Regulation Order.

You have requested the following information:

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I am writing to formally request the following information regarding the City of Coventry (City Centre High Street Area)(Prohibition of Driving & No Entry)(Experimental) Order 2024:

1. Revenue Data

- Total revenue generated to date from Penalty Charge Notices (PCNs) issued under this Order.

Nil no penalty charge notices have been issued.

- Breakdown of how this revenue has been spent or allocated.

2. Consultation and Public Engagement

We can confirm that no objections were received to the phase 1a ETRO. The Order expires in December.

3. Signage and Enforcement Data

- The Department for Transport approval or guidance for signage used in the restricted area.

All signs associated with this initiative are in line with the requirements as set out in the Traffic

- Number of PCNs issued by date, location, and vehicle type.

Nil no penalty charge notices have been issued

4. Monitoring and Evaluation

- Any documents, reports, or meeting minutes showing how the effectiveness and fairness of the scheme are being reviewed.

This matter is due to be presented to the September meeting of the City Service Cabinet Member Decision Session at which time a review of the scheme will be considered and a decision taken as to whether the scheme should be made permanent.

- The criteria that will be used to decide whether to make the Order permanent.

A decision will be taken based on feedback received from the scheme during the statutory consultation period which ran over the first 6 months of the scheme along with site observations and assessments which will be used to determine if the objectives of the original order as set out within the statement of reasons have been met.
