- A Hackney Carriage Clearway on the west bound side of Judds Lane from a point 52m easterly of its junction with Jimmy Hill Way (A444) to a point 112m easterly of its junction with Jimmy Hill Way (A444)

The Order is proposed for the purposes of improved public safety, easier vehicular access and a more amenable and safer route for pedestrians accessing the football stadium.
