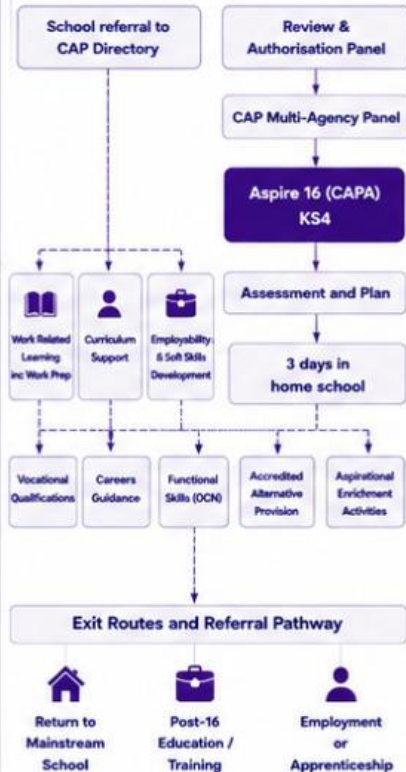

Building skills, confidence and aspirations for the future.



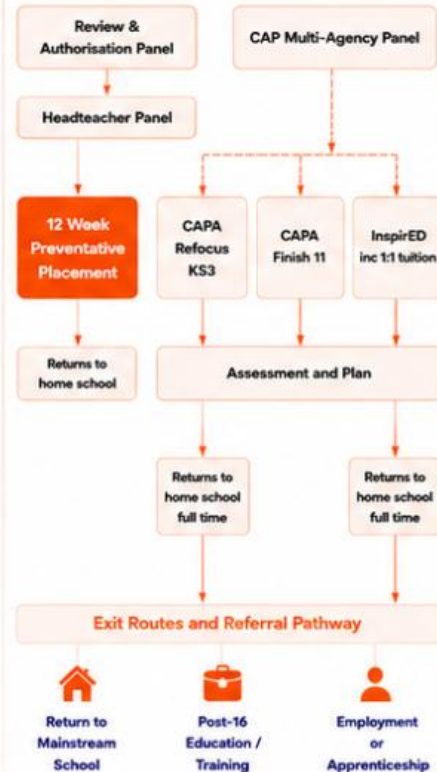
THERAPEUTIC PATHWAY

Therapeutic support to improve wellbeing, confidence and readiness.



ENGAGEMENT PATHWAY

Re-engaging learners and supporting consistent attendance and progress.



TIER 3

TRANSITIONAL PATHWAY (LA SECTION 19 DUTIES)

Intensive support for permanency excluded students or students with medical needs. Statutory duty of the Local Authority.



REFERRAL ROUTES

Students receiving a Section 19 placement following permanent exclusion or medical needs are referred by the Local Authority.
