Who we are

At Encompass, we are dedicated to providing an inclusive and supportive learning environment for children aged 5-25 with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) who do not have a current learning centre placement. We believe in the potential of every child, striving to create a space where individuals with SEND can thrive academically, socially, and emotionally. Our focus is on delivering a personalised provision that empowers each child to reach their full potential.



What we offer



At Encompass, pastoral support is embedded across all of our programmes to ensure that every learner—regardless of age or need—feels safe, valued, and supported. Our approach is trauma-informed, inclusive, and person-centred, with a strong focus on emotional wellbeing, self-regulation, and communication. We use tools such as Zones of Regulation, social stories, and sensory strategies to help learners manage emotions and behaviour in a safe, supported way. For those using alternative communication methods such as PECS, Makaton, or AAC, we ensure that their voice is heard and their preferences respected. As learners progress, especially within the Care Certificate programme, we place emphasis on self-advocacy, helping young people express their care needs and rights with confidence. Our team also supports the development of practical life skills—from hygiene and organisation to travel and time management—preparing learners for greater independence in education, employment, or adult life. We promote identity, equality, and dignity across all settings, helping each learner feel seen and celebrated for who they are. This is supported by a wraparound “team around the learner” approach, including qualified educators, healthcare professionals, and family partnerships, with regular EHCP reviews and personalised plans to meet individual wellbeing goals.

Student Outcomes

At Encompass, student outcomes are measured not only by academic or vocational achievement, but by meaningful progress in independence, confidence, and self-awareness. Learners leave our programmes with practical skills for life and work—ranging from completion of the Care Certificate to functional communication, emotional regulation, and daily living competencies. They develop the ability to advocate for their needs, make informed choices, and participate actively in their communities. Many progress into supported internships, vocational training, or entry-level roles within health and social care settings. Across all age groups, learners show improved self-expression, greater resilience, and a deeper understanding of themselves and others. Each outcome is underpinned by personalised goals linked to EHCPs, ensuring that every learner moves forward with purpose, dignity, and a clear sense of possibility.
