Students have ongoing daily check ins and where appropriate are supported using the happy chimp method. Trade skills offer a positive neutral subject to encourage communication, they provide an opportunity to prove that they can achieve amazing things. All of our sessions are broken down into a series of small achievable goals.

Student Outcomes

Improved familial connection, improved behaviour, social mobility, better career opportunities, improved confidence and behaviour, improvement in fine and gross motor skills, improved vocabulary, hands on plumbing, tiling and carpentry skills.
