Sport England note the continuation of the employment land allocation JE2:4 Land at Baginton Fields and South East of Whitley Business Park and housing allocation H2:19 Land at Mitchell Avenue, both sites include playing field land which could be lost as a result of the development of the sites. It is also noted that Policy GE2 Green Space allocates two sites for the provision of new sports pitches, to support the allocation of JE2:4 and H2:19.

Sport England are unable to identify the potential replacement playing field sites highlighted in Policy GE2, with the site not appearing to be displayed within the proposal map. As such, Sport England are unable to make an assessment as to whether the two sites would be at least equivalent in quantity and quality to that proposed to be lost at site allocations JE2:4 and H2:19, in line with NPPF paragraph 104b and Policy GE2.

Linked to this if there is a loss of provision playing field land, no assessment has been submitted to demonstrate that the playing field land (and ancillary provision) is surplus to requirement in accordance with the abovementioned policies. As part of this a local assessment of need should be provided having regard to the Council's Playing Pitch and Outdoor Sports Strategy 2023.

As such it is considered that the allocation of JE2:3 and H2:19 is not justified as it has not been demonstrated how the allocations meet the requirements of NPPF paragraph 104. Consequently, there is no justified reason as why the sites should not be subject to all of the policy requirements set out in Policy GE2.

Sport England consider all site allocations which would result in the loss of playing field land (and ancillary provision) should be subject to Policy GE2 to ensure compliance with the requirements of NPPF paragraph 104.

Sport England therefore consider the below text (strikethrough) should be removed from Policy GE2.

### Policy GE2

1. Development involving the loss of green space that is of value for amenity, recreational and/or community use will not be permitted unless specifically identified as part of a strategic land use allocation, or it can be demonstrated that.....

More specifically, it should be demonstrated that Land at Charter Avenue and Land East of Coundon Wedge Road, proposed replacement sites for allocations H2:19 and JE2:4, meet the requirements of NPPF paragraph 104b (and Sport England Exception Policy E4). It should be noted that Land at Charter Avenue appears to be an existing playing field site, and it has not been demonstrated that it is not required to meet any shortfalls in playing field provision independent of being mitigation for the loss of proposed site allocation H2:19.

If the above, is not demonstrated Sport England consider that GE2 point 4 is deleted to ensure conformity with NPPF paragraph 104:

To support the proposed allocations at H2:19 and JE2:4 the following sites are allocated for the provision of new sports pitches:

Land at Charter Avenue (former Alderman Harris School site). Land east of Coundon Wedge Road.
