Whilst these are generally reflected in the reasoned justification and proposed wording of Policy HW1, nevertheless it is disappointing that an updated Health SPD and a checklist to assist in factoring in health considerations for smaller applications has not been produced in the meantime to ensure that the matters raised by the PCCWM have been fully taken into account.

The PCCWM therefore requests that an updated Health SPD be prepared swiftly to sit alongside emerging Policy HW1.
