Dear policy colleagues,

Thank you for the consultation on the Coventry Local Plan Review Regulation 19 stage.

We welcome the references to the historic environment throughout the document and also the Heritage Background Paper, which forms part of the Plan's evidence base, but note that no Heritage Impact Assessments have been prepared to inform the proposed site allocations. Thus, we have concerns about several allocations, primarily in respect of the Plan process and how the historic environment has been considered.

Bearing in mind that this is the first opportunity we have had to comment on the proposed site allocations, we do have strong concerns regarding two sites, namely H2:30 and H2:32. For both of these sites, we have real concerns about whether the quantum of development proposed can be delivered, without substantial harm to the historic environment, and we object to these site allocations as a result. We would be happy to discuss these with you further ahead of submission and any EiP hearing sessions, to establish whether concerns can be addressed.
