What we offer



The course covers basic motorcycle maintenance, health and safety, teamwork, problem solving and integration of English and Maths. Tuition on motorcycle riding also forms part of the course.

Assessment takes place via student workbooks which are completed during the day alongside tutor observations.

Learners will focus on the personal development qualifications once these have all been achieved they will then continue to work towards an award for Maths and English skills (see qualifications below)

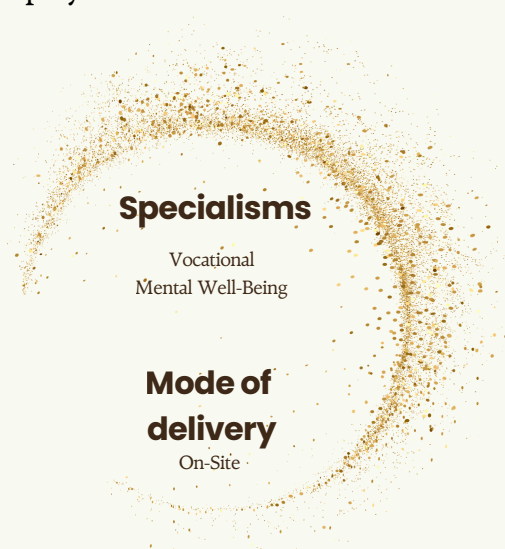
