

## **NOTICE OF MAKING**

### **City of Coventry (Allesley Park Area)(20mph Speed Limit) Order 2025**

Notice is hereby given that Coventry City Council ("the Council"), under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), has made the above Traffic Regulation Order ("the Order") which will come into operation on Friday, 5 September 2025.

The effect of this Order shall be to introduce a 20 miles per hour speed limit to improve safety and amenity on the lengths of road named below:
