Thank you for your request for information relating to Looked after children and care leavers aged 16.18.

You have requested the following information:

I am writing to make a Freedom of Information Act request for information about the Council's provision for supported accommodation for looked after children and care leavers aged 16-18, as now regulated by Ofsted.

Please may I have the following information:

1. Number of children and young people placed in supported accommodation by the local authority as at 28/7/25 broken down by (a) the type of supported accommodation (i.e. semi-independent, supported lodgings etc) and (b) the status of the CYP (i.e. LAC, UASC etc).

Number of children in supported accommodation: 83

By supported accommodation type: 82 semi-independent 1 supported lodgings
