

Notice of Intent
Proposed Road Hump (Raised Table) Siddeley Avenue

Notice is hereby given that Coventry City Council ("the Council"), under Section 90 of the Highways Act 1980, intends to install a road hump (raised table) no more than 75mm high on Siddeley Avenue.

It is intended the raised table will be installed on Siddeley Avenue at its' junction with Armstrong Avenue and the access road to the Sphinx Club development. Approach ramps to the raised table will be located on Armstrong Avenue and the access road leading eastwards to the Sphinx Club development.

The proposed traffic calming feature should assist to reduce vehicle speeds and aid road safety at this location.
