Thank you for your request for information relating to Local Hotel Use and Funding for Asylum Accommodation.

You have requested the following information:

- 1. The number of hotels or temporary sites in Coventry used for asylum accommodation as of the most recent month available.**
- 2. The approximate number of individuals housed in such accommodation.**
- 3. The total council spend on asylum-related services in 2023/24 and 2024/25, and the value of reimbursement received from the Home Office for those years.**
