

PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

City of Coventry (Harnall Lane East) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2026

Notice is hereby given that Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order ("the Order").

The proposal is to extend an existing 'No Waiting at Any Time' restriction on the following parts of Harnall Lane East:

- On the south side, from a point 30m easterly of the roundabout with Clifton Street, in an easterly direction for 12 metres.
- On the north side, from the junction of Stockton Road in a westerly direction for 3m.
- On the north side, from a point 20m easterly of Stockton Road, for a distance of 4m.

The restriction is proposed to assist pedestrian traffic by prohibiting parked vehicles in proximity to a Zebra crossing.

The details of the changes proposed by this Order are contained in the Statement of Reasons and the Map Tiles all of which are available on the Council's website (see link below).
