Thank you for your request for information relating to Tuition services for children and rates paid.

You have requested the following information:

Please provide the following information regarding tuition services for children funded by the council:

1. What is the hourly pay rate for tutors providing home tuition or alternative provision to children funded by the council?

We pay external providers between £46.00 and £59.54 per hour

This is not applicable for Home Tutors employed by the Council. They are salaried employees and therefore not hourly paid.

2. Is this rate based on the School Teachers' Pay and Conditions Document (STPCD), National Joint Council (NJC) pay scales, or another pay structure? Please specify which scale/point.

For Homes Tutors employed by the Council, they are on teachers' pay and conditions (not NJC), all on UPS grade, scales 1 to 3 which ranges from £45,646 to £49,084 per annum.

3. If the council uses agency providers to supply tutors, what hourly rate should those agency tutors be paid after 12 weeks under the Agency Workers Regulations 2010?

We are advising you as per Section 1(1) of the Act that this information is not held.

4. Does the council have written policies requiring agency providers to comply with the Agency Workers Regulations 2010 regarding equal pay after 12 weeks?

This is not written into Council policy. We can advise that Hays (the Council's contracted agency) comply with the Agency Workers Regulations 2010, therefore they comply with the rules on equal pay after 12 weeks.
