

**CITY OF COVENTRY (LONDON ROAD)
(7.5 TONNE WEIGHT RESTRICTION) (EXPERIMENTAL) ORDER 2026**

Notice is hereby given that Coventry City Council ("the Council"), under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), has made the following Experimental Traffic Regulation Order ("the Order"), which comes into effect on 2nd March 2026.

The Order is proposed in order to reduce the number of HGVs using those parts of London Road set out in the Schedule below

The Order will be implemented on an experimental basis for eighteen (18) months, and it's effectiveness reviewed before a decision is made on whether to make it permanent. The Council may make the Order permanent or abandon it.
