

## **NOTICE OF MAKING**

### **City of Coventry (Citywide) (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Designation, Waiting Restrictions, Loading Restrictions, Loading Areas and Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2016 – (Variation 14A) Order 2026**

Notice is hereby given that Coventry City Council ("the Council"), under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), has made the above Traffic Regulation Order ("the Order") in part which will come into operation on Monday, 30<sup>th</sup> March 2026

The effect of the Order shall be to:

- i) Add, vary or amend waiting restrictions on certain lengths of the following roads:-

Adam Road, Ashwood Avenue, Baxter Close, Birmingham Road, Bishopton Close, Bridle Path (The), Brindley Paddocks, Brinklow Road, Brownhill Green Road, Cash's Lane, Centenary Road, Coat of Arms Bridge Road, Coppice (The), Darrach Close, Eden Road, Everdon Road, Felton Close, Fenside Avenue, Hallam Road, Hockley Lane, Lavender Avenue, Lincroft Crescent, Lyndhurst Croft, Mohawk Bend, Monticello Way, Nod Rise, Pennington Way, Providence Street, Queen Mary's Road, Silverton Road, Stoney Stanton Road, Thamley Road, Wainbody Avenue South, Watersmeet Grove, Woodway Lane

- ii) Introduce Residents' Permit Parking Schemes on the following lengths of road:-

THAMLEY ROAD - All properties in Thamley Road will be eligible to apply for Zone TR Parking Permits.

- iii) Extend the existing residents' permit parking schemes as follows

Zone EL – to include Properties 137 to 187 Woodway Lane (odd numbers only)

Zone EW1 – to include properties in Silverton Road and properties 673 to 693 Stoney Stanton Road (odd numbers only)

- iv) The following that formed part of the original proposals, have been deferred and will not be included in the Order:

- a) The introduction of a Disabled Person's Parking Place restriction for Acacia Avenue
- b) The introduction of a Waiting Restriction: Daily 6am to 10pm, 4 hours (whilst charging) with No Return in 4 hours
- c) The introduction of a No Waiting At Any Time restriction in Rowington Close
- d) The introduction of a No Waiting At Any Time restriction in Shire Close

When originally advertised on 11<sup>th</sup> December 2025 the title of the Order was City of Coventry (Citywide) (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Designation, Waiting Restrictions, Loading Restrictions, Loading Areas and Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2016 – (Variation 14) Order 2025 and it has since been changed to that above.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from today, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
