Thank you for your request for information relating to Disposal of Vehicles.

You have requested the following information:

I would like to request the following information regarding Coventry City Council's arrangements for the disposal of vehicles, including Coventry City Council fleet, seized, recovered, abandoned, or end-of-life vehicles:

1. The name of the current contractor(s) responsible for vehicle disposal, including any auctioneer, salvage operator, or Authorised Treatment Facility (ATF) used by Coventry City Council.

With regards to vehicle disposal including 3rd party vehicles that are abandoned, seized and recovered, the Council has a contract with Rowley Autos. For details of this contract please refer to the Council's Contract Register.

In relation to the Council's own vehicle fleet, Fleet Services will arrange the disposal of the fleet. This will be through auction companies such as Manheim Auctions or British Car Auctions, depending on the vehicle or vehicle type. If any vehicle does not have any resale value, such as scrap or damaged beyond repair, Rowley Autos is appointed to assist with its disposal.

2. The contract title and a brief description of the services provided.

3. The contract start date, end date, and any extension options.

Start Date: 01/05/2023

End date (Original Term): 30/04/2026

Option to extend (which has been enacted): One (1) 12 month extension to an expiry no later than 30/04/2027.

4. The total contract value or estimated annual value.

Total Contract Value £150,000.

5. The procurement route used to award the contract (e.g., open tender, framework, direct award).

Competitive Open Procedure.

6. Whether the contract is expected to be re-tendered upon expiry and when this may be.

With regards to COV-15112, it is anticipated that this contract will be re-tendered in time for 01/05/2027.
