Thank you for your request for information relating to Total annual cost of Speed Camera maintenance.

You have requested the following information:

I would like to know exactly how much it costs the Coventry taxpayer to maintain the current average speed camera infrastructure across the city.

1. How much they've cost so far to install.

To date the Council has invested £1.7 million over the six phases currently delivered. This has been funded by the City Region Sustainable Transport Settlement (CRSTS). CRSTS is a capital funding settlement between the West Midlands Combined Authority (WMCA) and central Government. The City Council receives an annual allocation from CRSTS with 2026/27 the final year of this settlement.

2. Is there an arrangement with West Midlands Police to recoup some of the costs through fines.

The operation of ASE generates two income streams:

- Fixed Penalty Notices – Revenue from fines goes directly to the Treasury.
- Speed Awareness Courses – Drivers opting for these pay a fee, which is retained by West Midlands Police (WMP) to cover course administration.

This second element from Speed Awareness courses is the only revenue returned to the scheme and contributes to ASE operational and maintenance costs as incurred by the Police as the

operators of the system and Local authorities who lead on their deployment and ongoing maintenance of the physical camera network.
