

STATEMENT OF REASONS

for

City Of Coventry (Owenford Road)(Waiting Restrictions) Order 2026

It is proposed to amend the existing double yellow lines as described in the table as part of the changes to the junction with Jubilee Crescent and the creation of the new echelon parking bays.

EFFECT

1. This Statement of Reasons relates to the making of the following Road Traffic Regulation Order.

- **City Of Coventry (Owenford Road)(Waiting Restrictions) Order 2026**

The general effect of these proposals will be to prohibit vehicles from parking close to the junction with Jubilee Crescent and to put a time limit of 2 hours in the new parking bays, from Monday to Saturday between 8am to 6pm. This matches the timings of the existing limited waiting bays on Jubilee Crescent.

2. The Director for Economic Growth delegated powers to approve the publishing of Traffic Regulation Orders

REASONS

3. When considering whether to make a traffic order the Council is under a duty pursuant to S.122 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway having regard to the matters specified in S.122(2). It is considered that the proposal will contribute to the safer movement of traffic.

Furthermore, it is considered that the proposals will affect matters specified in S.122(2) as follows:

(a) the desirability of securing and maintaining reasonable access to premises;

Reasonable access to premises will be maintained, as no changes to access or egress is proposed. The proposed changes will not affect access to any premises.

4. The proposed traffic order is to be implemented in accordance with Section 1(1), Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) as it appears to the Authority that it is expedient to make them:

(a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising

(c) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians)

(e) for preserving the character of the road in a case where it is specially suitable for use by persons on foot

(f) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs

5. The proposed changes and the authority's reasons are as follows:

Owenford Road – prohibition of waiting and 2 hours limited waiting Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm no return within 4 hours.

The Order will amend sections of double yellow lines on both sides of Owenford Road and protect the junction with Jubilee Crescent. The new echelon parking bays on Owenford Road are to be managed with a 2 hour time limit.

Road in the City of Coventry	Extent
Owenford Road Northern side	No waiting at any time - From its junction with Jubilee Crescent eastwards for a distance of approximately 13 metres and then between points 16m and 19m then points 22m and 26m east of that junction.
Owenford Road Southern side	No waiting at any time - From its junction with Jubilee Crescent eastwards for a distance of approximately 16 metres.
Owenford Road Northern side	2 hours limited waiting Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm no return within 4 hours. - From a point approximately 13 metres east of its junction with Jubilee Crescent for a distance of approximately 3 metres, then between points 19 m and 22 m then points 26m to 33 m east of that junction
Owenford Road Southern Side	2 hours limited waiting Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm no return within 4 hours - From a point approximately 16 metres east of its junction with Jubilee Crescent eastwards to a point approximately 38 metres east of that junction.
