

**PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER**

**City of Coventry (Humber Road)**  
**(Revocation of Right Turn Ban into Whitley Depot) Order 2026**

Notice is hereby given that Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order ("the Order").

The effect of the proposed Order is to revoke the existing right turn prohibition for southbound traffic on Humber Road turning into Whitley Depot.

The details of the changes proposed by this Order are contained in the Statement of Reasons and plan all of which are available on the Council's website (see link below).
