

## **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

**for**

### **City Of Coventry (Humber Road) (Revocation of Right Turn Ban into Whitley Depot) Order 2026**

It is proposed to revoke the above restriction following the construction of the Humber Road cycle scheme. The changes to the layout mean the right turn ban can now be removed.

#### **EFFECT**

1. This Statement of Reasons relates to the making of the following Road Traffic Regulation Order.

The general effect of these proposals will be to allow southbound vehicles to turn right into Whitley Depot.

2. The Director for Economic Growth delegated powers to approve the publishing of Traffic Regulation Orders

#### **REASONS**

3. When considering whether to make a traffic order the Council is under a duty pursuant to S.122 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway having regard to the matters specified in S.122(2). It is considered that the proposal will contribute to the safer movement of traffic.

Furthermore, it is considered that the proposals will affect matters specified in S.122(2) as follows:

*(a) the desirability of securing and maintaining reasonable access to premises;*

Reasonable access to premises will be improved as right turns will be permissible.

4. The proposed traffic order is to be implemented in accordance with Section 1(1), Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) as it appears to the Authority that it is expedient to make them:

*(c) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians)*

5. The proposed changes and the authority's reasons are as follows:

Humber Road Revocation of Right Turn Ban into Whitley Depot

The Order will revoke the right turn ban and enable southbound vehicles to turn right into Whitley Depot.
