Thank you for your request for information relating to Traveller sites/pitches.

You have requested the following information:

**1. How many permanent residential caravan sites are in your local authority?
Of these sites, how many are set up and available for travellers to move to?**

There are two permanent residential caravan sites within the City of Coventry, neither owned or managed by Coventry City Council.

One is a privately owned extended family site that is at capacity – 14 pitches.
The second is a Housing Association site, also at capacity 12 pitches.

**2. How many permanent residential pitches are in your local authority?
Of these pitches, how many are available and set up for new traveller tenants?**

26 pitches – both sites at capacity with a waiting list for the Housing Association site.

**3. How many transit caravan sites are in your local authority?
How many are available and set up for travellers to move to?**

Not applicable no transit site provision.

4. How many households are on your waitlist for a suitable pitch on a traveller site?

We advise as per Section 1(1) that we do not hold this information. Coventry City Council does not hold a waiting list for the pitches on the Traveller sites.

5. Did you apply for funding to build traveller pitches as part of the 2016 – 2023 Affordable Homes Programme?

If so, how much funding did you receive? And how many pitches did you build?
