

Notice of Intent
London Road South Cycleway
Proposed Raised Tables and Controlled Pedestrian/Cycle Crossings – London Road

Notice is hereby given that Coventry City Council ("the Council"), intends to install physical traffic calming measures and controlled crossings on London Road as part of the London Road South Cycleway Scheme.

The details of the proposed measures are as follows: -

A. Raised Tables to be installed on the following junctions with London Road (pursuant to S.90 of the Highways Act 1980)

- i) Carnegie Close
- ii) Sunbury Road
- iii) Stonehouse Lane

The said Raised Tables to be of a height of 100mm to 125mm.

B. Controlled Pedestrian/Cycle Crossings to be installed on London Road at the following locations (pursuant to S.23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984):-

- i) Pedestrian Crossing approximately 100 metres south of Abbey Road
- ii) Toucan Crossing – approximately 11 metres south of Robert Close
