As part of Coventry City Council’s Education team, Coventry Music works collaboratively with schools, families, and community partners to ensure inclusive access to music for all children and young people. Now integrated into Heart of England Music Hub—serving Coventry, Warwickshire, and Solihull—Coventry Music plays a key role in a wider strategic network, expanding opportunities and resources across the region. With a passionate team of music educators and flexible support staff, Coventry Music reaches over 7,000 students annually, hosting large-scale events and nurturing musical talent citywide.

Experienced in alternative provision education, supporting students with SEMH and SEN/D needs. Mental Health First Aid trained and qualified in youth work.

Student Outcomes

Coventry Music’s in-school and after-school alternative provision supports hard-to-reach and disengaged young people, including those in pupil referral units. Previous programmes have led to improved engagement, behaviour, and personal development through music-led learning. The new offer is delivered from an on-site space at Media Mania, based at The Daimler Powerhouse, which includes rehearsal rooms and a professional recording studio. Students will form bands, take part in studio recording sessions, develop podcasting skills, and perform live—building confidence, teamwork, and creative expression in a supportive, youth-led environment.
