Who we are

Onside Education provides two key services designed to support both schools and students: Our on-site reintegration programme, delivered directly within schools, offers students a structured and supportive break from mainstream lessons. This intervention helps to reduce instances of negative behaviour and exclusions by promoting emotional regulation, re-engaging learners, and preparing them for a smooth transition back into the classroom environment. In addition, we operate a dedicated off-site alternative provision based at the state-of-the-art Vision Football Factory—a fully equipped indoor sports facility. This provision builds on our reintegration model and caters to KS3 and KS4 students, delivering a tailored curriculum that supports academic progress while also offering clear pathways into further education, vocational training, and employment, particularly in sports, coaching, and related industries. We specialise in supporting students with low attendance, low self-esteem, SEMH needs, or undiagnosed SEND, providing personalised interventions that remove barriers to learning and build confidence, resilience, and motivation. Our curriculum balances personal development with academic continuity, ensuring that students can reintegrate into mainstream education without significant gaps in their learning, and with the skills needed to succeed both in and beyond school.

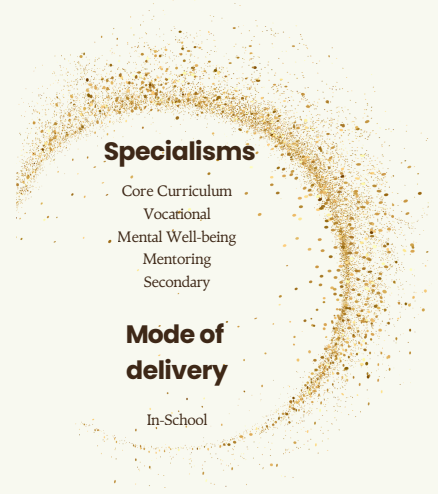
