What we offer



Coventry Outdoor Education through CAP provides specialist support for children and young people who are struggling to engage in mainstream education due to factors such as social, emotional and mental health (SEMH) needs, anxiety, trauma, ADHD or autism. The provision uses outdoor learning and therapeutic experiences to help students build resilience, confidence, self-regulation and positive social skills. [coventry.gov.uk].

Key programmes include:

- Flourish Programme – a behavioural intervention programme designed to improve mental wellbeing, emotional regulation, social interaction, independence and self-esteem through structured outdoor activities.
- EOTAS (Education Other Than At School) – a 12-week programme providing education in an outdoor setting, helping young people develop confidence, overcome anxiety and discover their strengths through challenge-based learning.

Overall, Coventry Outdoor Education's Alternative Provision offers a nurturing, therapeutic environment that supports vulnerable students to re-engage with learning, improve wellbeing and develop the skills needed for future success
