

PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

**CITY OF COVENTRY (JUDD'S LANE AND ROWLEY'S GREEN LANE)
(NO STOPPING AT ANY TIME AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2026**

Notice is hereby given that, Coventry City Council ('the Council'), pursuant to its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order ("the Order").

The effect of the proposed Order shall be to introduce:

- A No Stopping At Any Time restriction along the length of Judd's Lane
- A No Stopping At Any Time restriction along that part of Rowley's Green Lane from its junction with Jimmy Hill Way (A444) to its junction with Judds Lane
- Limited Waiting for Buses only on the southern side of Judds Lane adjacent to Coventry Football Stadium
- Limited Waiting on the southern side of Judds Lane adjacent to the Coventry Football Stadium

The Order is proposed for the purposes of improved public safety, improved vehicular access and a more amenable and safer route for pedestrians accessing and egressing the football stadium.
