

## Who we are

Milestone Meadow is a calm and supportive alternative provision dedicated to helping children rebuild confidence and rediscover a love of learning. Designed for KS1 and lower KS2 pupils, the provision supports children with a wide range of SEND needs, including those experiencing school anxiety or emotionally based school avoidance. At the heart of Milestone Meadow is a nurturing, personalised approach. With small group sizes of up to 10 pupils, children benefit from a structured yet flexible environment where their individual needs are understood and supported. The provision offers a bespoke, play-based curriculum enriched by outdoor learning experiences, enabling pupils to develop academically, socially, and emotionally. Led by experienced SEND professionals, Milestone Meadow places a strong emphasis on wellbeing, emotional regulation, and engagement. Through close partnership with schools and families, the provision aims to support every child's progress and successfully transition them back into school or an appropriate educational setting.



## What we offer



Milestone Meadow provides a nurturing, calm environment where pupils feel safe, supported, and understood. Our pastoral approach focuses on emotional wellbeing, confidence building, and re-engagement with learning. We offer individualised support, consistent routines, and strong relationships with trusted adults. Our trauma-informed practice supports emotional regulation and positive behaviour, while structured opportunities help develop social skills. We work closely with families and schools to ensure a joined-up approach, supporting each child's progress and successful transition back into education.

## Student Outcomes

Pupils at Milestone Meadow make meaningful progress in their emotional wellbeing, confidence, and engagement with learning. Through personalised support and a nurturing environment, children develop improved emotional regulation, positive social skills, and increased resilience. Many pupils successfully re-engage with education, showing improved attendance and readiness to learn. Where appropriate, we support pupils to transition back into mainstream school or move on to a suitable long-term provision, equipped with the skills and confidence to succeed.
