Adapt-Ed is a specialist Alternative Provision delivering structured 1:1 education for young people aged 10–18 who struggle in mainstream environment or small group settings. We support learners with ADHD, Autism, SEMH needs and other additional needs, aligning all provision with EHCP outcomes and individual learning plans. Our model combines accredited learning, mentoring and therapeutic-informed practice to support engagement, emotional regulation and measurable academic progress. We work collaboratively with schools, Local Authorities and multi-agency teams to ensure safeguarding, consistency and clear reporting.



What we offer



Dedicated 1:1 mentoring support, emotional regulation planning, structured behaviour support strategies, trauma-informed practice, access to qualified therapeutic practitioners (HCPC/BACP/UKCP registered) as an optional enhancement, multi-agency collaboration and regular progress reporting to commissioning schools and Local Authorities.
