Thank you for your request for information relating to Blue Badge enforcement.

You have requested the following information:

Under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, please provide me with full answers to each of the following questions regarding your authority's enforcement of Blue Badge misuse:

If this is not possible under Section 12 then please provide the number of Blue Badges withdrawn.

1. How many Blue Badges has your authority withdrawn in each year since 2018, including 2026 to date?

We do not hold all the requested information and are advising you as per Section 1(1). We only have records since 2019.

Reasons for revoked badges are not recorded without accessing individual records which are only accessible for one year due to data protection legislation. Where the information is available and accessible within a reasonable time frame, we have recorded the reason.
