6. Does the Local Authority consider there is sufficient residential and nursing provision to meet the needs of adults with neurological needs in the local authority area?

Providers are typically able to accommodate the majority of individuals requiring residential or nursing care, and there is usually capacity within the market to meet assessed needs. However, there are occasions where individuals present with highly complex needs, including those with significant behavioural, clinical, nursing or specialist neurological requirements. In these cases, sourcing an appropriate placement can be more challenging and may take longer due to the level of specialism required or limited availability of suitable placements at that time.
