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## Introduction

The Coventry Education Data Team 'Key Statistics Report' is a summary of school and pupil related statistics published by the Department for Education (DfE), compiled from data collected locally from schools and from all local authorities.

This report has been produced by the Data Team, who work closely with Coventry schools to collect, process and analyse their school and pupil information.

The Data Team also maintains 'Data Watch', which is a comprehensive suite of up-to-date reports, with charts and graphs, for Coventry schools. 'Data Watch' is an interactive product, which has been designed by the team to enable schools to quickly access and compare latest data with national and city trends. The system is also used by central staff to work in partnership with schools and review local authority data.
